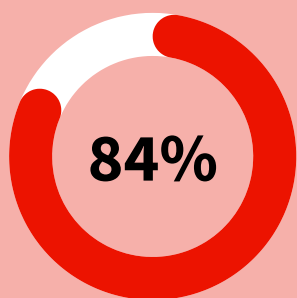


Support a Tax Credit for New Jersey Family Caregivers

Across New Jersey, family caregivers assist their parents, spouses and other loved ones so they can live at home — where they want to be — and out of costly, taxpayer-funded nursing homes. These family caregivers help with bathing, dressing, transportation and much more. Many also contribute financially to their loved one's care. AARP recently surveyed New Jersey registered voters age 50+ about caring for their families and the cost of being a caregiver. **Here's what we learned:**



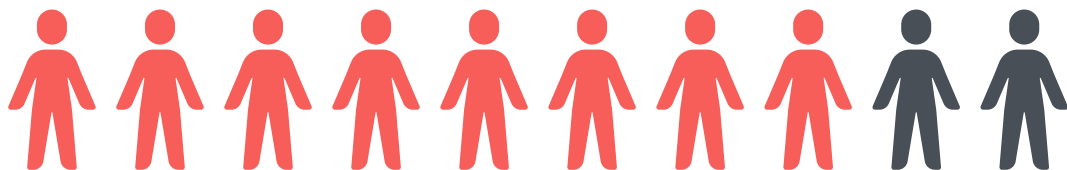
The vast majority of New Jersey voters support expanding the state's tax credit for Veteran caregivers to all family caregivers who care for older loved ones.



Nearly all New Jersey voters say it's important to have services that help people stay at home for as long as possible.



of New Jersey voters 50+ have experience as family caregivers.



76% of caregivers report emotional stress due to caregiving responsibilities.



Nine in ten family caregivers have incurred expenses while caring for a loved one.



Nearly six in ten family caregivers spend at least 21 hours per week providing care.



Almost four in ten family caregivers say they have a worse financial situation than before the pandemic.
